

Gives me immense pleasure.



Sun Temple

The Konark Sun Temple was built from Stone in the form of a giant Ornamented Chariot dedicated to the Sun god, Surya... The Konark temple presents this iconography on a grand scale. It has 24 elaborately carved stone wheels which are nearly 12 feet (3.7m) in diameter and are pulled by a set of seven horses. The temple is known for the exquisite stone carving that covers the entire structure. It is the best-known tourist destination in Orissa and has been a World Heritage Site since 1984.

Ashoke Sen is one of the few elite scientists in the world who have made original contributions to the subject of String Theory. He won the Fundamental Prize in Physics in 2012 with a total prize money of \$3 Million. He was later awarded the Padma Bhushan for his work in 2013. In recognition of his contributions to the field of Physics, Dr. Sen is nominated as a Fellow of the Royal Society. Prof. Sen now works at the Harish Chandra Research Institute in Allahabad.
